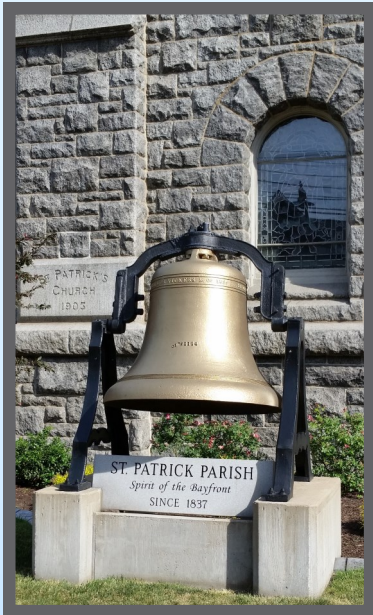

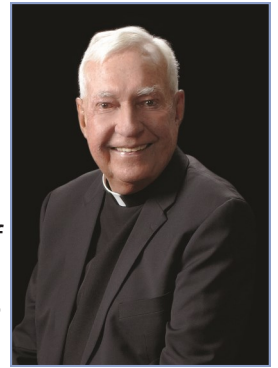

From the Pastor's Desk...



Today is the Fourth Sunday of Advent. Isaiah's 8th century BC prophecy is set in the context of the brutal Assyrian empire, and a coalition of smaller states against it. When Ahaz, ruler of Judah, refused to join the coalition, some of the neighboring kingdom's marched against him. In the face of Ahaz's wavering, Isaiah assured him that the coalition would not prevail and that he should put his faith in the Lord. Isaiah encourages him to ask for a sign from the Lord, but Ahaz refuses to tempt the Lord. Seeing through Ahaz' hypocrisy, Isaiah sounds exasperated. Not only has Ahaz wearied the people; he has also wearied God. In response to this weariness, we hear the Lord promise that a virgin will conceive and bear a son, we see it fulfilled in Mary's giving birth to a Son who is Emmanuel.

Paul begins his letter to the Romans by introducing himself and his gospel. Similar to prophets who were seen as slaves of the Lord, Paul is a slave of Jesus Christ. To be a slave in the biblical sense implies total, unwavering obedience. Secondly, Paul identifies himself as an apostle. Then he identifies himself as one "set apart for the Gospel of God." Throughout the New Testament we see new, unexpected fulfillment of the Jewish tradition that can be understood only in light of the Christ event. Not only is Jesus the son of David, he is also the Son of God, revealed through his resurrection from the dead. In just a few words, Paul announces the heart of the Good News: Jesus, Son of David, born in the flesh, risen in power who will now rule over us. Later he will develop how Jesus will send the Spirit to guide us.

Matthew opens his gospel with two accounts of Jesus' origin. The first is a long genealogy telling of Jesus' human ancestry. Today he describes his birth. He begins by telling of Mary's betrothal to Joseph, the first step of marriage. Often because of her youth, the woman remained in the home of her parents until the public ceremony took place. When Mary was found to be pregnant, Joseph faced a dilemma. According to the law, she was guilty of adultery and was subject to stoning. After Joseph decided to be merciful, an

angel appears in a dream. Matthew will use dreams in his gospel as they are prevalent in the Old Testament. After Joseph acts as commanded by the angel, the virgin gives birth to Emmanuel, God with us; thus fulfilling the prophecy made by Isaiah to Ahab.

After a priest in South Carolina refused communion to presidential candidate Joe Biden, Biden's bishop (Bishop Fran Malooly of Wilmington, Delaware and a classmate of mine) issued a statement saying that he "would refrain from ever politicizing the Eucharist. His preference, as with most bishops, is to interact with politicians individually who disagree with significant church teaching."

A reminder that the Christmas Eve 5 PM Mass is our largest Mass of the year. The church will be completely full by 4:30 and people will be standing everywhere. I ask that people not try to save seats for family or friends. We need to have those seats available as people arrive.

The parish office will close at noon on Christmas Eve and not reopen until Thursday, January 2. I will be here the entire time if there is an emergency or the need for a funeral. This is always the slowest week of the year in the office, and it's a good opportunity to give the staff time to enjoy the holidays with family and friends.

The diocese is changing all of its computers to Windows 10 which means that each parish has to do the same if we want to continue to receive information, etc. from the diocese. We have started the transition, but it's not gone as smoothly as we had hoped. One of the things we've discovered is that our webpage is not able to be put on Windows 10. They tell us that the webpage is really outdated and needs to be completely rebuilt. One of our parishioners, Deb Slusarz, designed the original webpage and has maintained it for the parish. She is now designing a new one which should be up and running soon. In the meantime, our webpage will be down for a brief time while she builds the new one. I'm told that the new one will be much faster and much easier to navigate.

After the first of the year we will begin to take

reservations for weddings in 2021, We only take reservations from parishioners during January, February and March. After that, if dates remain, we can take reservations from non-parishioners. I wish I could accommodate everyone who wants to be married here, but we've grown so much as a parish that we simply can't do that any longer. I have to keep dates open also because some women in the parish might receive an engagement ring at Christmas and want a date for next year. Just a reminder that all weddings here are wedding ceremonies, not the wedding Mass.

I recently had lunch with David Gibbons, CEO of UPMC Hamot, Boo Hagerty, head of the Hamot Health Foundation and parishioner B. J. Lechner who orchestrated our securing a piece of property from Hamot so that we can construct a building to house our festival materials. I'm thrilled to tell you that Hamot is very generously giving us this parcel of land on a long term lease at \$1 a year. David said if we tried to go through corporate in Pittsburgh to buy it, we could be years waiting because they have so many other land deals in the works. In the spring, we'll put up a building that can house the festival material. I'm particularly grateful to B. J. Lechner who orchestrated all of this for the parish.

St. Martin's Center picked up all of the Christmas gifts for the children which you so generously donated. They told me that no other parish that participates in this Silver Star program provides the quantity and quality of gifts that you do. There were 11 bikes in the gifts. Those children are so deprived of things in life and you are making a difference in their lives this Christmas. Many of them asked for clothing items, and you purchased them for them as well as different types of gifts. It breaks your heart to read the request from one small girl who asked that someone give her a bed for her to sleep in. Obviously, she is sleeping on the floor because the family cannot provide a bed for her. God bless you for your generosity.

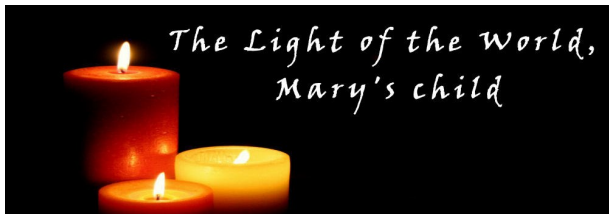
