





## ***From the Pastor's Desk...***



Today is the Fourth and last Sunday of Advent. Micah announces the coming of a messianic king in Bethlehem, David's hometown, but insignificant among the villages of Judah. Rather than a geographical precision about where the Messiah is to be born, this is a theological oracle announcing his humble style: his triumph is not with the sword nor with a spectacle of power, but "He shall be peace." But first, a time of purification is necessary, during which Israel will be subjected to foreign powers. This preparation will end with the birth of the king who will rule his people, or "pasture" the flock.

The author of the Letter to the Hebrews addresses the theme of salvation by comparing the one single sacrifice of Christ with the endless sacrifices of the first covenant. The sacrifices prescribed by the first covenant do not win salvation. Christ's coming into the world replaced the former offerings with the sacrifice of fulfilling God's will, with the perfect offering, once and for all, of his own body, which sanctifies us. The author puts in Christ's mouth the strong words, "I come to do your will, O God." In becoming flesh, Jesus showed how to live according to God's will.

The drama of our gospel presents four actors: the Old Testament, personified in Elizabeth; the New Testament, personified by Mary; divine grace incarnate, present in the Virgin's pregnancy, and John the Baptist, in Elizabeth's womb. Of the four, John takes the initiative and leaps in his mother's womb as he celebrates God's presence in her womb. The old self is Elizabeth, barren but now open to new frontiers. The child within her moves under the vision that is felt in encountering the mother of the Lord. We call this impulse conversion. The Old Testament teaches that we cannot free ourselves; God takes the initiative. Humanity, personified in John, previously trapped in a dark, enslaved history, begins to work, run and jump in the presence of God's grace. Dance plays a role because the Israelites danced in the procession before the Ark of the Covenant and

David danced before the Ark of the Covenant. John the Baptist dances in the womb of the elderly Elizabeth before the Ark of the New Covenant. Days before the celebration of the birth of the one who would be God's new covenant with us, we meet John in the bosom of the Old Testament, in the presence of the New, his leap celebrates the change coming in our lives.

Our Christmas Mass schedule is on Monday, Christmas Eve, there will be a Mass at 5 PM and another Mass at 9 PM. On Christmas Day, the Masses are at 8 AM and at 10:30 AM.

Allow me to wish each of you a blessed and holy Christmas with a prayer that the coming of the Christ might somehow bring peace to our violent and troubled world.

I have always closed the parish office the week between Christmas and New Years to give the staff a break. In addition, it is the slowest time of the year. I'm here the entire time if there is any need. You can call me on my own phone—454-4032. The office is now closed for the holiday and will reopen on Wednesday, January 2. There will be no morning Masses this week.

During the month of October, our parish food pantry served 550 families which included 199 children and 93 elderly people. We distributed 11,279 pounds of food at a cost to the parish of \$599.77. Once again, thanks to your generosity we are able to continue providing this much needed service to people.

Things are falling in place for our Overflow Homeless Shelter which we will host again for one week in February. Angie Kontur is continuing as chair and this year, a number of people who had played key roles in this project are unable to do so for a variety of reasons. Both Angie and I are thrilled that so many new people stepped up and are volunteering to fill those empty slots. We can house up to 75 people on any given night. Parishes throughout the city take turns hosting the Shelter.

The diocese now has a webpage that is updated weekly with diocesan news. Anyone can access it by going to [nwpacatholic.com](http://nwpacatholic.com). The site has

updated news of things happening in the diocese.

Students from the Diocese of Erie have received \$5,391,700 in grants and scholarships from Gannon University for the 2017-2018 school year. 334 students qualified and received \$503,750 in Gannon Diocesan funds. Students receiving Gannon's High School or Parish award were able to obtain an additional \$4,887,900 renewable financial assistance. Parish grants are awarded to new, full-time Gannon students who are active members of a parish in the Diocese of Erie. Those grants total \$2,000. In addition, new full-time freshmen Gannon students who graduate from a Catholic high school in the Diocese of Erie and enroll directly out of high school are eligible for additional grants. Those grants total \$3,000. Grants are then renewable each year for students who maintain a 2.0 or better cumulative grade point average and complete a minimum of 24 credits each year. I mentioned that we once again will host a week-long Overflow Shelter for the Homeless in early February. To do so, we rent the Social Center at the Church of the Nativity. The total costs for the week are about \$5,500. We have to pay rent on the Social Center, have a cleaning service come in each day to thoroughly clean the place, particularly the bathrooms, we purchase clothing, boots, etc. for the clients and it all adds up. Most of the clients are people suffering from mental illness and they simply don't have the skills to take care of themselves, and the churches in the city step in and provide them with these services. People will come to give them haircuts, dentists donate time to take care of their teeth, nurses come to check their health, etc. Every need is covered. I always ask people not to give them money when they ask for it because it will only go for drugs or alcohol. Your January packet of envelopes will contain an envelope if you would like to make a donation to help with these costs. In addition, we are still in need of some volunteers.

A father comes home with a bag of candy and says to the kids, "I'm going to give all of this to the person who never talks back to mommy and always does what they're told. Now who's going to get them?" And the kids reply, "You are."

**Pro-Life Breakfast**




